Scott Britton is Executive Director of The Castle Museum in Marietta, Ohio. He is a frequent speaker on a plethora of topics related to the Civil War and multicultural history in Southeastern Ohio. He conducts educational programs for students and adults, including frequent tours of Marietta's historic cemeteries. Scott is a graduate of Penn State University and is Past Commander of the General B. D. Fearing Camp #2 SUV and historian for the Marietta Chapter SAR. He co-founded the Civil War Round Table in 2012 and has served as guide on each annual field trip where he relates the stories of veterans from the region at the battlefield positions where they served our nation.

Don Pfanz is an author and staff historian at Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania National Military Park. He is a native of Gettysburg, PA, and graduated from the College of William & Mary before joining the National Park Service. Prior to joining the Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania NPS Staff he served at Petersburg National Battlefield and Fort Sumter National Monument. He is the author of five books including *No Turning Back: A Guide to the Overland Campaign; Richard S. Ewell: A Soldier's Life; The Letters of General Richard S. Ewell, Stonewall's Successor;* and, *War So Terrible: A Popular History of the Battle of Fredericksburg.*

- Historical marker projects





Brig. Gen. Don Carlos Buell Buell's Island, Lowell, Ohio Dedicated October 7, 2017 Erected October 2017





- Charter bus transportation with departure from Lowes Home Improvement Center, 842 Pike Street, Marietta, at 6:00 a.m., and, WV Park & Ride at the intersection of US 50 and I-77, Parkersburg WV, at 6:20 a.m. on Friday, September 12, 2024.
- Admission and narrated tours of each of the attractions, battlefields, and sites indicated.
- Overnight accommodations at Country Inn & Suites by Radisson, 656 Warrenton Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22406 — See https://www.radissonhotels.com/en-us/ brand/country-inn
- Dining venues in the nearby picturesque Fredericksburg Historic District are a short shuttle ride on the charter bus from our hotel and offer a diverse range of dining options and pricing. A local dining guide and map of the historic district will be provided following registration.

- Our charter bus will return to the WVDOT Park and Ride in Parkersburg at approximately 6:30 p.m. and Lowe's Home Improvement Center in Marietta at approximately 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 15, 2024.
